



## Zweigelt 2013

<b>Region</b>	Burgenland, Austria
<b>Winemaker</b>	Josef Umathum & Wolfgang Peck
<b>Grape Type</b>	100% Zweigelt
<b>Production</b>	15,000 cases
<b>Alcohol</b>	13.0%
<b>Vinification</b>	Hand harvested from end of September to mid October, fed into a gentle pneumatic press. Fermentation in stainless steel vats at 28°C to 30°C, 10% finishing in used oak barrels.
<b>Vineyards</b>	The grapes grow in our vineyards around the village of Andau which is characterized by dry, gritty and mineral soils. Our region called Seewinkel is the driest and hottest in Austria and gives ideal conditions for the production of high quality red wines.
<b>Tasting Notes</b>	Incredibly deep red characterizes our Zweigelt. On the nose the wine shows deep fruit of fresh cherries and dark berries with some hints of cinnamon. On the palate the wine seduces with juicy fruit paired with fine acidity. The medium body is backed up by fine acidity and ends in a long and elegant finish.



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
